NATIONAL AFFAIRS

• Highlights of India's 71st Republic Day:

On January 26, 2020 India celebrated its 71st Republic Day. The day honours the date on which the Constitution of India came into effect i.e. on 26 January 1950. The highlights of the republic day functions are as follows:

- Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro attended as chief guest.
- A total of 16 states and Union Territories(UTs) and 6 central ministers participated in the Republic Day Parade at Rajpath in New Delhi. Jammu & Kashmir participated in the parade for the 1st time as a union territory.
- 4th generation army officer Captain Tania Shergill (26 years) who became the 1st woman officer as Parade Adjutant on Army Day Parade, led the corps of signals under the motto 'Teevra Chaukas' (swift and alert).
- Dhanush gun system Army Air Defence marching contingent took part for 1st time.
- The President of India Shri Ram Nath Kovind, approved the conferrement of Jeevan Raksha Padak Series of Awards-2019 on 54 persons.
- Indian Army's (IA) Srinagar (Jammu & Kashmir) based 15 corps commander Lt Gen Kanwal Jeet Singh Dhillon was awarded with Uttam Yudh Seva Medal.
- Indian Navy's commodore Jyotin Raina was awarded the Nao Sena Medal

<u>Jharkhand' Jharia is the most polluted Indian city</u> <u>& Lunglei, Mizoram least polluted: Greenpeace</u> <u>India report 2018 :</u>

The **Greenpeace India report** for **2018** was released based on the National Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Programme (NAMP), on January 21, 2020. **Jharia** in Jharkhand which is known for Coal-belching is the **most polluted** Indian city with 322 μ g/m3 (micrograms per cubic meter) of PM10 (Particulate matter) pollutants in 2018, according to the report analysis of 287 cities across the country. Out of 287 cities 231 cities were severely polluted.

- (i) Dhanbad in Jharkhand which is known for its rich coal reserves and industries, is the secondmost polluted Indian City with 264 un/m3 of PM10 pollutants.
- (ii) By taking marginal improvement in reducing air pollution, **Delhi** had jumped to the **10th** position in

the analysis . It was at the 8th position in the last report.

- (iii) Lunglei in Mizoram is the least polluted followed by Meghalaya's Dowki.It is also the only Indian city with PM levels under the World Health Organisation's (WHO) prescribed level of 20/ug/m3 (micrograms per cubic meter).
- (iv) Noida, Ghaziabad, Bareilly, Allahabad, Moradabad and Firozabad are the six of the top-10 polluted cities in Uttar Pradesh.
- <u>EIU's 12th edition of Democracy Index 2019: India</u> slips 10 ranks to 51st position, Norway tops:
 - On January 22, 2020, According to the **12th** edition of the **'Democracy Index 2019: A year of democratic setbacks and popular protest'**, released by the **Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU), India** has slipped 10 ranks to **51st spot** with the score of 6.90 in this index, which provides a blueprint for the current state of democracy in 165 independent states and two territories.

Top & bottom: Norway tops the list with a score of 9.87 while **North Korea** is at the **bottom** with 167th place with 1.08 points.

<u>India Opens 1st Mahatma Gandhi Convention</u>
 <u>Centre in Niger</u>

On January 21, 2020, India's Minister of External Affairs (MEA) Shri **Subrahmanyam Jaishankar** and Nigerian President Mahamadou Issoufau inaugurated the first convention centre in Africa namely "**Mahatma Gandhi convention centre**"(MGICC) established at the state of **Niger** in Western Africa by India to honour the memory of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. This is the **1st** centre established in Africa by India under grant assistance. Mr.S.Jaishankar was the **first Indian-foreign Minister** to visit the West-African country during his national trip visit to Niger (West Africa) and Tunisia (North Africa).

Key Points:

- (i) The Convention centre has been designed with modern and eco-friendly facility including a 2000 capacity of Plenary hall (wide participation from African Union Member states).
- (ii) It is likely to host the forthcoming African Union AU Summit in the new convention center which will further contribute towards enhancing of bilateral ties.
- (iii) **Contribution to Niger:** India has provided Lines of Credit(LoC) worth \$96.54 million to Niger for projects in transport, electrification, solar energy and potable drinking water.

• <u>'Vigyan Samagam', India's 1st global Mega Science</u> <u>Exhibition inaugurated at National Science Centre</u> <u>in New Delhi by Dr. Jitendra Singh</u> On January 21, 2020, the Union Minister of State Independent Charge (I/C) Ministry of Development Of North Eastern Region, Minister of State (Mos) Prime Minister's Office (PMO), Personnel, Public Grievances, and Pension, Minister of State for Department of Space. Dr. Atomic Energy and Jitendra Singh inaugurated India's first global Mega Science Exhibition "Vigyan Samagam" at National Science Centre, New Delhi.The exhibition is organized by the Department of Science and Technology (DST) and the National Council of Science Museums (NCSM) under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) & will be held from January 21, 2020, to March 20, 2020.

• France to be the guest of honour at 2022 New Delhi World Book Fair:

On January 22, 2020 France ambassador to India, Emmanuel Lenain has announced that **France** will be the **guest of honour** at New Delhi World Book Fair for the year 2022 (**NDWBF 2022**) as part of the reciprocal invitation as New Delhi was the guest of honour for 2020 Livre Paris (Paris Book Fair).

• 1st ever 2-day long "Innovation festival" was organised by Arunachal Pradesh govt at Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh

On January 25, 2020 Arunachal Pradesh state council for science & Technology (APSCS&T) in partnership with National Innovation Foundation organised the 1st ever Innovation festival at science centre IG Park, Itanagar Arunachal Pradesh. The two days festival aims to encourage the cultural innovation among the people and students of Arunachal Pradesh.

• <u>12th South Asia Conference held in New Delhi</u> Defence Minister Shri Rajnath Singh addressed the 12th edition of the South Asia Conference at the Institute for Defence Studies and Analysis (IDSA) in New Delhi from January 28-29, 2020. The conference deals with issues related to economic cooperation for development, changing political context in India's neighbourhood etc. The theme of the conference was India's "Neighbourhood First" Policy: Regional Perceptions.

Key Points:

- (i) The Govt's commitment of about \$13.14 billion in credit-lines and about \$4 billion in assistance to the neighbouring countries over the last decade were discussed.
- (ii) Participants: All members of SAARC and Myanmar participated in the conference. Members of the South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC)countries were called for cooperation to end terrorism.
- (iii) Members present: The IDSA Director General Ambassador Shri Sujan R Chinoy and other senior military & civil officials of the Ministry of Defence(MoD) were present on the occasion.

• <u>Switzerland mints world's smallest gold coin values</u> <u>1/4 Swiss francs</u>

On January 23,2020 Switzerland state-owned Swissmint has minted **World's smallest gold coin** of 2.96 millimeter (0.12 inches). The coin features a face of scientist **Albert Einstein** sticking out his tongue. It weighs 0.063 grams (1/500 th of an ounce) and has a nominal value of 1/4 Swiss francs (USD United States Dollar- 0.26).

Key Points:

- (i) Its weight is comparable to that of 2 grains of rice.
- (ii) Swissmint has minted 999 coins which will be sold for 199 francs with a special magnifying glass to see Einstein's face.

- Highlights of 50th WEF annual meeting 2020 held in Davos, Switzerland The 50th edition of the 2020 World Economic Forum (WEF) annual meeting was held in Davos-Klosters, in Switzerland from January 21-24, 2020. The theme for the year 2020 was "Stakeholders for a Cohesive and Sustainable World". The WEF summit aims to engage world leaders to collaborate for global, regional and industrial development etc. The highlights of the summit in detail are as follows:
 - On January 23, 2020 the World Economic Forum (WEF) has announced new internet security principles which will help nearly 1 billion users.
 - The **1st** ever public **blockchain** track and trace platform built to help businesses respond to the demands of customers for ethical and environmentally friendly products.
 - **1st global consortium** was formed and it works on designing a framework for **digital currency governance** that also includes stablecoins.
 - The republic of **India** has joined as a **founding govt member** of the WEF's **'Reskilling Revolution**'.
 - The O.P Jindal Global University (JGU) signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the University of Zurich (UZH) in Switzerland for mutual cooperation in higher education and research.
 - Madhya Pradesh(MP) govt has made investments worth Rs. 4,125 crores at WEF from various investors.
 - The govt of **Karnataka** signed a pact with WEF to start "**Centre for Internet of ethical things**".
 - The Malaysia Digital Economy Corporation (MDEC) signed a pact with WEF to focus on drones.
 - The **Tata steel Kalinganagar** (**TSK**) in Jajpur district of Odisha, was honoured at the WEF 2020 for its recent admittance to the **Global Lighthouse Network**(GLN) of WEF.
 - Bollywood actress Deepika Padukone was honoured with 26th Crystal award 2020

- <u>Katerina Sakellaropoulou becomes Greece's first</u> woman president
 - On January 22, 2020, independent candidate **Katerina Sakellaropoulou**(63 years), became the**1st Woman President** of **Greece** elected by Greece's Parliament for a period of 5 years. She will be officially sworn in as Greece's **13th President** in April, 2020. She will succeed Prokopis Pavlopoulos, the current president.
- CEC Sunil Arora takes over as the new chairman of FEMBoSAOn January 24, 2020 India's Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) Sunil Arora took over as the new Chair of the Forum of the Election Management Bodies (EMBs) of South Asia (FEMBoSA) for the year

2020 during the **10th annual meeting** of FEMBoSA held in New Delhi. Sunil Arora succeeds K.M. Nural Huda, CEC of Bangladesh. FEMBoSA is a regional association of Election Management Bodies (EMB) of SAARC (South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation) countries and has 8 members.

• Sunil Mehta got appointed as Chief Executive of Indian Banks' Association On January 27, 2020, Former managing director (MD) and chief executive officer(CEO) of Punjab National Bank (PNB), Sunil Mehta, took over as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Indian Banks' Association (IBA). Mehta will replace VG Kannan, who resigned from office as chief executive of IBA on December 31, 2019.

- <u>Monty Python star Terry Jones passed away at 77</u> On January 22,2020 Terence Graham Parry-Jones, a member of the Monty Python (Comedy group) passed at the age of 77 in London, England due to dementia. He was a very famous actor and writer who played a variety of characters in the iconic comedy group's flying circus TV series, and had also directed several of their films. In past, an asteroid, 9622 Terryjones, was named in his honour.
- <u>Former Minister of Odisha, Jagannath Rout passes</u> away at 77:

On January 24, 2020 Senior Congress leader and former Minister of Odisha, **Jagannath Rout** has passed away at a private hospital in Bhubaneswar, Odisha due to cardiac arrest. He was 77.

• <u>Assamese litterateur Sashi Sarma passed away at 89</u>: On January 29, 2020 Famous Assamese litterateur Sashi Sarma, 89 years old passed away at his home Nalbari, Assam due to age-related ailments. **Awards:** Sarma had received Soviet Nehru Award in 1968 & the Sitanath Brahma Chowdhury Award from Assam Sahitya Sabha.

PLACES IN NEWS

• India's 1st War Memorial for Animals to be set up in Meerut, UP

On January 23, 2020 the govt has announced to set up country's **1st war memorial** for service **animals** such as dogs, horses, mules in **Meerut**, Uttar Pradesh(**UP**). This war memorial will come at army's specialized breeding, rearing training centre for animals in the Remount and Veterinary Corps (RVC) Centre and College in Meerut.

Key Points:

(i) Names of 300 dogs, 350 handlers, few horses and mules that had dedicated their life in various military operations like Kargil war etc will be inscribed in the granite tablets in the memorial. **Mansi**, a labrador breed dog who was awarded the **highest honour of animals** will top the list of animals to be remembered.

- (ii) The Indian army currently has more than 100 dogs, 5000 mules and 1500 horses.
- <u>13th Jaipur Literature Festival began in Jaipur,</u> <u>Rajasthan:</u>

The **13th** edition of the Zee **Jaipur Literature Festival** (JLF) began at Diggi Palace Hotel in **Jaipur**, **Rajasthan** on January 23, 2020, and will be conducted till January 27, 2020. The 5-day long festival was inaugurated by Chief Minister of Rajasthan Shri Ashok Gehlot. Author **Ashwin Sanghi** launched his book '**The Vault of Vishnu'** through Sonali Bendre Behl at the fest. The **Bloomsbury Anthology of Great Indian Poems** edited by poet-diplomat **Abhay K** was also launched. It includes 200 poems.

• <u>Arvind Krishna awarded Mahakavi Kanhaiyalal</u> <u>Sethia Award:</u>

Renowned poet and literary critic **Arvind Krishna Mehrotra** was awarded **5th** edition of the **Mahakavi Sethia Award** for poetry during JLF 2020. The award is given in memory of Rajasthani and Hindi poet Kanhaiyalal Sethia and carries a cash prize of Rs. 1 Lakh.

India's first e-waste clinic opens in Bhopal

On January 24, 2020 India's first e-waste clinic was opened in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. The e-waste clinic was inaugurated by C K Mishra (Secretary to the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change,MoEFCC). The e-waste clinic was jointly set up by the Central Pollution Board Control -CPCB and Bhopal Municipal Corporation -BMC.

On January 31, 2020 Indian Hockey women's team captain and 2020 Padma Shri awardee **Rani Rampal** became the 1st ever hockey player to win the **2019 World Games Athlete of the Year**' award. The announcement was made by the world games. Hailing from Haryana, Rani has obtained 1,99,477 votes from fans worldwide.

Key Points:

- In 2019, India won the FIH (Fédération Internationale de Hockey) series finals where Rani was named Player of the Tournament.
- (ii) About award: The award is an initiative of IWGA (International World Games Association) that recognizes and honours an athlete or a team for their outstanding performance or for their social commitment or particularly, fair behaviour. 2019 was the 6th edition of the IWA.
- Ministry of Home Affairs announces Padma awards 2020 ; Arun Jaitley, Sushma Swaraj honoured On January 25, 2020, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA),Government of India (GoI) on the eve of 71st Republic Day, announced the names of Padma awardees for 2020, which is the highest civilian Awards in the country. The Padma Awards are conferred under 3 categorized viz- Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri. This time (2020) a

total of list had **141 awards** – **7** celebrities have been chosen for **Padma Vibhushan**, **16** celebrities for **Padma Bhushan** and **118** personalities for **Padma Shri**. They will be conferred by the President of India, Ram Nath Kovind at ceremonial functions which will be held in Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi at around March/ April 2020.

The formal announcement was made by Rangers FC and Bengaluru FC at Kanteerava Stadium, Bengaluru, Karnataka.

<u>Key Points:</u>

- $(i) \quad Bala \ Devi \ is \ the \ Ranger's \ first-ever \ Asian \ footballer.$
- (ii) She is the current top-scorer for India, netting 52 times in 58 games & also the top international goal scorer in the South Asian region.
- (iii) Bala Devi was named as AIFF Women's Player of the Year twice (2015 & 2016) and has been top-scorer in the Indian Women's League for 2 seasons.
- Overview of 3rd Khelo India youth games 2020 held in Guwahati,Assam The 3rd edition of Khelo India Youth Games (KIYG) 2020 was held at Karmabir Nabin Chandra Bordoloi

Indoor Stadium in **Guwahati**, Assam with the participation of over 10,000 students. **Vijay** the Tiger and **Jaya** the Blackbuck were the **mascots** of the tournament.

Australia to host 11th Indoor Cricket World Cup in October, 2020 11th Edition of the Indoor Cricket World Cup is to be hosted by Australia from October 10 to 17, 2020. The World Indoor Cricket Federation (WICF) announced the tournament will be held at indoor cricket venues in Melbourne, Australia in Casey Stadium and City Power Centre.

<u>Key Points:</u>

(i) The 2017 Indoor Cricket World Cup was held in Dubai, United Arab Emirates (UAE). Australia team won the Indoor Cricket World Cup continuously in both men's and women's categories for the last 25 years without losing a single match.

- (ii) Cricketers from nearly **10 countries** will compete in the tournament in **4 categories**: under-21 men and women and open men and women.
- (iii) Australia is already hosting Women's and Men's T20 World Cups this year.

About Indoor Cricket World Cup: The event is organized by the sport's governing body, the World Indoor Cricket Federation (WICF) and is held every 2 or 3 years. The first Indoor Cricket World Cup match held in England in 1995.

• <u>6 cities across New Zealand to host the ICC</u> Women's cricket world <u>cup 2021; Hagley oval in</u> <u>Christchurch to host final</u>

On January 23, 2020, According to the ICC Women's Cricket World Cup CEO Andrea Nelson, 6 cities namely Auckland, Wellington, Hamilton, Tauranga, Dunedin and Christchurch of New Zealand will host matches of the 2021 edition of the Women's cricket World Cup. The final of this tournament will be played at the Hagley Oval in Christchurch.

Key Points:

- (i) A total of 31 matches will be played between the 8 teams in the ICC Women's World Cup 2021 from February 6 – March 7,2021.
- (ii) The entire program of this world will be announced in March, when the event will officially launch. The 50over 2021 World Cup will provide a glimpse of the global development of women's cricket and New Zealand is preparing vigorously for the successful event of the tournament.
- (iii) The ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2020 is scheduled to be held in Australia between 21 February and 8 March 2020.
- <u>2021 ICC Women's Cricket World Cup:</u> It will be the 12th edition of the Women's Cricket World Cup.

 <u>Reliance Jio becomes 1st telecom operator to launch</u> <u>UPI payments feature</u>

On January 20, 2020 telecom operator **Reliance Jio** of the Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) has become the **1st** Indian **telecom operator** to launch **UPI** (Unified Payments Interface) **payments** space. Thus Reliance Jio will now compete with other private UPI payment providers such as Paytm, Google Pay and PhonePe.

<u>Key points:</u>

- (i) As of now, Reliance Jio is India's largest telecom operator.
- (ii) As per reports, users cannot use their existing UPI ids to avail this service. Instead, they will have to create a new JIO UPI Id.
- <u>New India Co-operative Bank(NICB) to be</u> <u>converted as Small Finance Bank</u>

On January 20, 2020 the New India Co-operative Bank (NICB) has been decided to convert into a Small Finance Bank (SFB) after being agreed by its shareholders under Voluntary Transition of Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks (UCBs) into SFB. NICB will now approach the Reserve Bank of India(RBI) and Central Registrar of Societies for further action.

Key Points:

- (i) The decision for conversion comes after RBI made regulatory changes following the Rs 4500 crore PMC (Punjab and Maharashtra Co-operative Bank) bank scam and to ensure enhanced regulations to lenders.
- (ii) The bank is currently operating in Maharashtra and Gujarat and has networth of Rs. 230 crores.
- (iii) A minimum of Rs.200 crore is needed to set up an SFB.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

 Indian Army to induct Artillery gun 'Sharang' by March 31, 2020
 On January 21, 2020, the Indian Army (IA) has announced to induct 1st batch of 18 indigenously upgraded 'Sharang' artillery guns by March 31, 2020. The announcement was made by the Programme

Coordinator of Sharang, Brigadier Jayant Kar.

Key Points:

- (i) Sharang: The artillery gun's barrel upgraded from 130mm to 155mm has a strike range of 39 kilometers and has gone integrated firing range from 0-45 degrees in its trial at the Long Proof Range of Ordnance Factory Khamaria, 16 kilometers from Jabalpur district headquarters in Madhya Pradesh. Previously the strike range was 27 kilometers.
- (ii) Upgradation contract: The contract to upgrade the Sharang artillery gun was undertaken by Gun Carriage Factory (GCF) in Jabalpur with the help of state-owned ordnance factories, and teams from the Army and DRDO (Defence Research and Development Organisation).
- <u>1st unmanned mission will be launched in December</u> 2020 as a preparation for 'Gaganyaan': ISRO

On January 22, 2020, According to the ISRO (Indian Space Research Organisation), chairman Dr Kailasavadivoo Sivan, ISRO would launch 2 ummanned missions in December 2020 and June 2021 in view of the launch of India's first manned spacecraft "Gaganyaan" in December 2021.

- The ISRO has prepared women robot 'Vyom Mitra'(means a friend in Sky) for sending into space under the 1st unmanned Gaganyaan mission.
- Indian flight surgeons are being trained in France to take care of the health of astronauts selected for Gaganyaan
- Pakistan successfully launched ballistic missile
 "Ghaznavi"

On January 23,2020 The successful training launch of nuclear-capable surface-to-surface ballistic missile(SSBM) **'Ghaznavi'** was held in Islamabad, Pakistan.The Ghaznavi missile strike targets upto a range of **290 km** (kilometers).

Key Points:

- (i) Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), the media wing of Pakistan's army mentioned that the Training launch was part of Field Training Exercise of Army Strategic Forces Command.
- (ii) The launch was witnessed by Lieutenant General Nadeem Zaki Manj (Director General Strategic Plans Division), Commander Army Strategic Forces Command, senior officers from the Strategic Plans Division, Army Strategic Forces Command, Scientist and Engineers of the strategic organisations.
- (iii) In November 2019, Pakistan had carried out a successful training launch of ballistic missile Shaheen-I which was also an SSBM.

Qualcomm launches 3 new chipsets - Snapdragon 720G, 662 &460 with Indian GPS system NavIC On January 21, 2020, In a major step to Made in India GPS (Global Positioning System) alternative, Qualcomm, an american multinational chipset manufacturer, has launched 3 chipsets in India -Snapdragon 720G, 662 and 460, along with the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO). All 3 chipsets feature Wi-Fi 6 connectivity and Bluetooth 5.1 support & the most important thing is that these 3 chipsets of Qualcomm have been developed with support for ISRO's Navigation with Indian Constellation (NavIC), a technology considered an advanced location positioning and navigation system than the GPS technology currently in use.

Key Points:

- (i) Apart from NavIC, these chipsets will also support the widely used GNSS (Global Navigation Satellite System).
- (ii) While Qualcomm's new chipsets, Chinese smartphone brands Xiaomi and Realme have confirmed that it will soon launch new smartphones with Snapdragon 720G chipset processor.
